

## **BIOTECHNOLOGY NATIONAL SEMINAR REPORT**

Introduction: K.V. R. Govt. College for women, Kurnool took an initiative to educate the students, update the faculty and create awareness among public about the importance of Life Sciences and its potential in improving human and animal health, increasing agricultural productivity and providing safe and clean environment. The seminar on New Horizons in Biotechnology was conducted by Department of Biotechnology on 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> Feb – 2015. It provided a platform to all the teaching professionals, Scholars to share the knowledge on advanced areas of research in science and technology. The Department of Biotechnology put maximum efforts from Day One to bring out all the information regarding Seminar Online in the website: <a href="http://new-horizons-in-biotechnology.webnode.com/">http://new-horizons-in-biotechnology.webnode.com/</a>. At the undergraduate level it is for the first time to happen in India to publish Conference Proceedings Online which added one more feather to the rich history of the college. This conference gave an opportunity to the faculty, scientists, industrialists, students and public at large to get updated with the current trends in Science and Technology.

## Day One: 09.02.2015

Inaugural Session: The program was started at 10:30 am by lightening of the lamp which was carried out by our Chief Guest Honourable Dy. Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh Sri.K.E.KrishnaMurthyGaru, Keynote speaker Prof.TPullaiah, President Indian Botanical Society and our Principal Dr. M. Purusotham Reddy. After that all the delegates were cordially invited by a prayer song.

The Chief Guest gave message on the importance of Biotechnology for human health & Agriculture. Later Souvenir and the preconference proceedings softcopy were releasedOnline on the website: <a href="http://new-horizons-in-biotechnology.webnode.com/by">http://new-horizons-in-biotechnology.webnode.com/by</a> the Chief Guest and eminent people on the dais. Simaltaneously Hard copy of the proceedings was also released. About 135 students (UG & PG), 118 staff and research scholars (apart from the students of KVR Govt.College for Women) were registered and 170 abstracts were submitted. Among them only 82 full length were published in the book with ISBN Number 978-93-82163-18-3.

Pre-Lunch Session: The Keynote address was given by Prof. Tpullaiah, President Indian Botanical Society gave lecture on PRODUCTION OF SECONDARY METABOLITES THROUGH TISSUE CULTURE. He explained the use of Biotechnology in improving the production of Secondary Metabolites which have vast pharmaceuticalimportance. He explained on innovative methods of production of novel compounds through biotransformation, somatic hybridization and selective gene transfer through recombinant DNA technology

The second technical session started at 12:15 pm by Dr.Santosh R Kanade, Department of Biochemistry & Molecular Biology, Central University of Kerala. He discussed on ENVIRONMENTAL CHEMICALS AND EPIGENETIC REGULATION which was more informative and research oriented. He explained how large number of chemicals like alkyl phenols, bisphenol-A, insecticides and pesticides effects on the functional outcome of epigenetic events like DNA methylation, histone modification and chromatin repression complex protein like polycomb proteins which causes many health problems in an early age of life.

Post Lunch Session: The session was started at 02:00 pm by Dr.H.P.Gurushankara, Department of Animal Sciences, Central University of Kerala. He delivered talk on GENES- CONCEPTS AND APPLICATIONS. Hediscussed on the past, present and future deliberation of genes as well as the most recent advances in the study of the organization of genes and their applications. Later Dr.V.Shyam Kumar, Resource person from Department of Biotechnology & Micro Biology, Karnataka University, delivered lecture on SILK SERICIN FOR DRUG DELIVERY APPLICATIONS. He explained about the fabrication of micro particles and sericin beads for drug targeted delivery.

After invited lectures paper presentation was given by participants from variousDegree Colleges, PG Colleges and Pharmacy Colleges from KadapaKurnool,Chittoor,Anantapuram,Tirupathi,Warangal,Khammam,Guntur,Vijayawad a,Vizagand Hyderabad.Research scholars from different Universities like Osmania University,TelanganaUniversity,SV University, SK University, Andhra University, Krishna University, University of Hyderabad,Kakatiya University, YSR Horticulture University,VignanUniversity,KLUniversity,Rayalaseema University, etc., presented their papers from 3-30 PM to 5-30 PM on Day One.

### Day Two: 09.02.2015

The technical session on Day Two was started by at 9.30 AM Dr.N.B.Thippeswamy, Department of MicroBiology, Kuvempu University, Shimoga. He delivered talk on EBOLA VIRUS DISEASE which causes severe haemorrhagic fever leading to up to 90% lethality. He explained about the two major factors in EBOLA VIRUS pathogenesis i.e., the impairment of the immune response and vascular dysfunction. He summarized the current knowledge on EBOV pathogenesis focussing on these two factors and on recent progress in the development of vaccines and potential therapeutics. The next talk was given by Dr.D. Subramanyam, Department of Biotechnology, Kuppam University on BIOMARKERS FOR DETECTION AND TREATMENT MANAGEMENT IN GYNECOLOGICAL CANCERS. He focused on the development of biomarkers based on the cellular and molecular approaches which include DNA, RNA biomarkers, Protein biomarkers, metabolic biomarkers, and pathological biomarkers with suitable clinical examples for accurate detection and management of gynaecological cancers.

The next technical session was opened at 11.30 AM after tea break by Dr. Meerza Abdul Razak, NatcoPharmaLimited, Hyderabad .He spoke on ROLE OF CORYNEBACTERIUM GLUTAMICUM IN WHITE BIOTECHNOLOGY WITH SPECIAL REFERENCE TO L-LYSINE PRODUCTION .He explained how White biotechnology provides significant benefits over the conventional chemical industry by production of chemicals and energy from annually renewable resources in a more energy-effective manner. He mainly focussed on the production of different biochemicalsproducedby C. glutamicum which are industrially important with special reference to L-lysine production. The session was continued by the next InvitedSpeaker, Dr. A. A. Haleem Khan, Department of Botany, Telangana University who spoke on STUDIES ON CRY PROTEIN FOR ANTIFUNGAL POTENTIAL WITH REFERENCE TO OBLIGATE FUNGAL PATHOGENS FROM CROP PLANTS . He focussed on the recent progress in the Bt technology and counter measures to prevent the development of obligate pathogenic fungi populations at spore stage from crop plants.

Post Lunch Session: After Lunch break the next session was started at 1.45 PM by Dr.B. Viswanath, Young Scientist, Department of Virology, SV University. He delivered talk on LIPIDS OF MICROALGAE: A BIODIESEL SOURCE. He stressed on interdisciplinary research of microorganisms and in particular microalgaewhich contain lipids and fatty acids as membrane components which can be used has source for biodiesel production.

After the invited talk Poster presentation session was followed at 2.30 PM. During this session 145students(65 KVR students+80 outside students) from different colleges presented 59 posters in Groups in Six sub themes of the Seminar. All their posters were judged by Dr.N.B. Thippeswamyand Dr.B. Viswanath. Two prizes were allotted for best poster in each Sub-Theme apart from two consolation prizes. The winners were given prizes during Valedictory session.




REPORT OF THE SEMINAR OF Dr. Ravoori Bharadwaja sahitya samalochanam


So I need to produce a brief report regarding the seminar.

He explained designing of the molecules using Computational chemistry before synthesis leads to the minimization of byproducts. The participants including faculties presented their views through their research papers.



### Post Lunch Sessions:

The Second Technical session has started at 2:00 P.M by Dr. V. Jayathirtha Rao, Chief Scientist IICT. He has explained the topic "Organic Materials for Emerging Applications: OLEDS and Solar Cells - Design, Synthesis, Characterization and Device Fabrication".




### Paper Presentation Session:
