





Property means bundle of rights. Intellectual property rights are the recognition of management of the property means bundle of rights. The prosperity achieved by developed nations is, to a large extent, the exploitation oft heir intellectual property.

There are many types Intellectual properties. Some oft hem are copyrights, introduced trademarks, trade secrets, industrial designs, protection of plant varieties and geographications etc. A Patent is a form of right granted by the government of an inventor to some others from making, using, selling offering to sell or importing an invention for a period is exchange for the public disclosure of invention. An invention is a solution to a section of the public disclosure of invention. An invention is a solution to a section requirements: it has to be new, not obvious, and there needs to be an applicability. Copyright gives the creator of an original work, exclusive rights to use it.

for a period of and time. It may apply to a wide range of creative intellectual or artistic forms or works. Copyright does not cover ideas and information themselves, only the form or the manner in which they are expressed. An industrial design right protects the visual design of objects. It consists oft he creation of shape, configuration or composition of pattern or color or configuration of pattern and color containing aesthetic value. Generally speaking, it is what makes a product look appealing and as such increases its commercial value. A trade mark is a recognizable name, mark, sign which distinguishes products or services of particular trader from similar products or services of other traders. Trade Secret is a formula, practice, process, or information of customers which is not generally known or reasonably ascertainable by which a business can obtain an economic advantage over its competitors or customers.

Balancing is required so thati ntellectual property rights are strong enough to encourage the creation ofi ntellectual goods but not so strong that hey prevent he wide use of goods or create scarcity of such goods in the market. Thatis the primary focus of modern intellectual property law. Justice Woodbury said: "the protection and interest of abors of the mind are also much the same as the protection of the wheat he cultivates or flocks he rears".

However, historically Intellectual Property Rights were granted only when they were necessary to encourage invention, limited in time and scope. This is mainly because knowledge being traditionally viewed as a public good, in order to allow its extensive dissemination and improvement hereof. But he modern global Intellectual Property regime is being dominated by high standards of protection with a vision that uniform application of hese standards over every country and to several fields with little consideration over social, cultural or environmental values or of the national level of economic development. It is due to these global pressures most off he Indian intellectual property laws have been drastically modified so as to make them in tune with the international intellectual property regime. One may argue that he emerging discourse on Intellectual Property law advocates for greater policy flexibility and greater access to knowledge, especially for developing countries. It must aim to reduce distortion especially on issues such as patients' access to medicines, internet users' access to information, formers' access to seeds, programmers' access to source codes and students' access to scientific articles and other literature. However, this shift has not yet manifested itself in concrete legal reforms at national and international level.

Being a responsible member of WTO, India not only committed itself to pec Intellectual Property Rights, but also enacted several legislations that am foster the growth of international trade & economic development. Introdu of IP legal framework paved way for conflicting issues such as Pharmac Se patenting versus patients access to drugs, cross border IP compliante use/dealing of Copyrights and protection of digital intellectual Property or gained attention over the recent years. Similarly Internet freedom and trading has witnessed several IP infringements ranging from conton violations to trademark infringement which in turn led to brand wars. For Internet alone contributed several IP law suits over the last one decade alarmed India to lean towards stringent internet regulations.

Though new legislations enacted in the field of Designs, protedio displays India's communications, Plant Protection, and Integrated displays India's commitment to WTO/ TRIPS Agreement in laying down legal IP regime. But the enforcement of these new IP legislation are not catching pace with the International IP developments viz. availability of IP experts & State appointed IP enforcement mechanisms

Further, due to lack of experts/special Judges (with a blend of science & law knowhow) to adjudicate law suits filed by stake holders under newly legislated IP laws, India is shambling in enforcing these IP laws. To address this issue, India shall focus on capacity building exercise for Science & Technology professional to deal with IP related issues. In addition to imparting the IP capacity building exercise to professionals, specialized IP courses shall also be inducted at the graduation level by revamping the existing curriculum to capture IP courses. Alternatively, there is also a need to impart specialized training through workshops & conferences, such as this conference to equip science & technology students with the understanding of IP Legislations and recent trends emerging thereto.

I see the present conference as an endevour to promulgate the importance of Intellectual Property Rights amongst students and other participants of the Conference.

I wish good luck and convey my best wishes to the Principal, Conference Convenor, Organising Secretary, KVR College for Women, its faculty, its contributors for organizing this Conference.
