STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY

2019-20

Student Satisfaction survey (SSS) consists of twenty-one questions. It is collected in the form of hard copy at random from the Final year degree students of 2019-20 batch wherein the students having studied for three years might have got the right say about the Institution and the Teaching Learning Process. The questions are scaled on five-point scale. '0' is the least grade and '4' is the highest grade. The 21st question is an open end question deriving student's real observation and to render positive suggestions to improve the satisfaction of students. Students thoroughly studied the questions and gave their responses without giving a space for partiality or fear.

Analysis:

Q.1. Syllabus coverage in the class

Analysis: 86.5 percent of the students responded that 85-100 % of syllabus is covered.

Q.2. Preparation of Teachers for the Classes

Analysis: 71 percent of the students responded well preparedness of teachers and the remaining students expressed satisfaction on the preparedness of students.

Q.3. Communication of Teachers

Analysis: 73.6 percent of the students expressed that the communication of their teachers is always effective.

Q.4. Teachers approach to teaching

Analysis: 67 percent of the students were graded excellent and the 31 percent of students graded very good.

Q.5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the students

Analysis: 75.2% of students accepted that internal valuation is always fair and 21.3% accepted it as usually fair and the remaining are sometimes unfair.

Q.6. Discussion of Assignments with the students

Analysis: 62.36 percent of the students agreed that assignments are discussed in the classes every time where as 37.64% of students felt that they are usually discussed.

Q.7. Promotion of internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities to students

Analysis: 64 percent of the students expressed their satisfaction on the promotion the above said whereas 35% of students offered the option often.

Q.8. Teaching and Mentoring process

Analysis: 56.74 percent of the students expressed that the mentoring process significantly and 41 percent of the students reported very well facilitates them in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

Q.9. Institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow

Analysis: 76.4 percent of the strongly agreed with the provision of opportunities by the Institution and the remaining students agreed.

Q.10. Teachers information about the expected outcomes of courses and Programmes

Analysis: 62.35 percent of the students opined that teachers provided competencies and the expected outcomes of courses and programmes and the remaining students opined usually.

Q.11. Mentors follow up with the assigned task.

Analysis: 65.16 percent of the students expressed as we have mentor and mentee ratio and the students interacted with the student's every time whereas 32 percent of the students opined usually.

Q.12. Illustration of concepts through examples and applications by teachers.

Analysis: 73 percent of the students agreed that the illustrations with examples are done every time. Remaining students opted the option usually.

Q.13. Teachers identification of Students strengths and encourage them to meet the right level of challenges.

Analysis: 80 percent of the student's fully opined that the teachers identify and encourage them where as the remaining students opted reasonably.

Q.14. Teachers are able to identify your weakness and help to overcome them.

Analysis: 61.23 % of students opted every time and 38.76 percent of the students opted usually.

Q.15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

Analysis: 71% of the students strongly agreed with the above question and the remaining 29% agreed.

Q.16. The institution uses student centric methods such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

Analysis: 65 percent of the students selected the option 4 to a great extent and the remaining students as moderate.

Q.17. Teachers encourages you to participate in extracurricular activities.

Analysis: 66% of the students strongly agreed whereas 34% of the students agreed.

Q.18. Efforts are made by the Institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

Analysis: 59% of the students opined the option to a great extent and 40% moderate and 1% sometimes.

Q19. What percentages of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc. while teaching?

Analysis: The option 4 - above 90% is chosen by 55.61% of students and 37% of students opted 70-89% and 7.3% opted 50-69%.

Q.20 The overall quality of teaching – learning process in your institute is very good.

Analysis: 68.5% of students agreed strongly and 31% of students opted agreed option.

Q21. Open end question for suggestions.

Analysis: Students expressed their satisfaction in general about Teaching Learning process of the Institute and desired to have skill/Vocational programmes.
