





I) Ratification of syllabi followed for I& II Years :

Zoology :

Advanced Telugu :

In semester V Bhashastraam – Anyadesalu, Adhana Pradhanalu added. Suggested to introduce courses linked with language and technology i.e. natural language processing and srilipi.

Advanced Urdu :

In semester VI, Knowledge of new version in research & criticism topic is added.

Economics :

Descriptive economic statistics cluster elective is added in semester VI to give basics of statistics for the students of economics. It is well appreciated by the academic council.

Political Science :

Some of the topics like IMF and World Bank, relation between neighbouring countries are clubbed. Local bodies in Andhra Pradesh is introduced in Sem. V.

Psychology :

Certain repeated topics like dependent personality disorder, Histrionic personality disorder is removed. It is suggested to introduce more add-on courses on Psychology.

American literature is added as it is one of the optional papers for NET/SLET. It is suggested to make some changes to make the students write IELTS and GRE.







An open elective on taxation is introduced for the II semester Students. It is suggested to introduce Women Entrepreneurship courses.
